

The 16 to 19 Tuition Fund 2021 to 2022 academic year

The 16-19 tuition fund allocated within the academic year 2021-2022 to The Bishop's Stortford High School will primarily be used to fund additional staff within the school to allow for small group tuition of GCSE English Language and Maths in order for pupils to obtain a minimum of a GCSE Grade 5 in the aforementioned subjects. There will be a total of four pupils in the Maths tuition group and one pupil in the English Language group.

In addition, staff will be deployed to run small group tuition sessions in a variety of areas and subjects that allow pupils to enhance skills in a multiple of areas that will assist their Key Stage Five attainment and help to bridge any gaps left by the pandemic. In all instances disadvantaged pupils will be prioritised and class sizes will be capped at six. Further details of additional interventions can be found in our [Covid Catch Up Statement](#). All pupils in living within the most deprived areas will be offered additional financial support in multiple areas including; resources, transport, enrichment, tuition and support for their Post-18 outcomes.
