(eg: 07000123456-SMITH). The inclusion of your mobile number will help us to contact you in the event of winning a prize. If you change mobile number in the future, you can update your standing order to reflect this and you will then remain contactable without having to inform TBSHS each time you change mobile number.

If you are already a member of either/both of the PSA/PTFA charities and were previously assigned a "Club Number", your "Club Number" is still in use and you do not need to change anything. The Unique Payee Reference system is being introduced for new members from September 2021 onwards.

Summary Information:	The Mitre Fund provides a platform for making either one-off or regular cash donations to the school, to support specific enrichment projects and to allow the school to continue to deliver an Outstanding experience, including our extra-curricular programme, for all of the students to engage in. Proposals from within the school are subject to approval by the Trustees. A recent substantial purchase was the canopy fitted adjacent to the servery. This has provided a covered area for students' use and has extended the space available for students to eat and socialise, especially during wet weather. More recently, funding has included specialist music technology equipment, additional IT facilities, extra library resources and a display unit in the school reception area to showcase Design Technology students' work.

Summary Information:	<p>The PTFA forms a very important part of the Parent/Carer community within the school, organising various social events throughout the year whilst raising money to benefit students of the school.</p> <p>We have now purchased seven concrete outdoor table tennis tables, picnic benches, theatre staging and lighting. Each year we also ask teaching staff for "Wish lists" for their subjects and have been able to purchase lots of extra equipment. In the past we have also contributed to the purchase of the school minibuses.</p> <p>TBSHS PTFA 300 CLUB - For £24 per year, you have the chance to win £100 each month (excluding August) and in December we have a "super draw", which has 3 prizes - 1st £150, 2nd prize £100 and 3rd prize £50.</p>
