School meal price increase

As is being keenly felt up and down the country, we are seeing significant increases in the cost of ingredients required to produce the food we sell in school. Our catering manager has tried extremely hard to source ingredients from various different suppliers in an attempt to keep costs down, though the lack of availability of many items just continues to drive the price up further. From the start of next term, the price of our lunchtime meal deal will increase by twenty pence from £2.75 to £2.95. Let me reassure you that, despite having a very high uptake from students, we do not make a profit from catering and will continue to keep the costs as low as possible. Any student eligible for Free School Meals will still be able to access the lunchtime meal deal each day.

Free School Meals

Your child could get a free school meal, worth over £450 per child per year if you receive some benefits. Full details and the online application can be found at

If your child is eligible for free school meals, they'll remain eligible until March 2023, or until they finish their current phase of schooling (primary or secondary), if that's after the end of March 2023.

1. Subject Changes:

Any further requests to change subjects should be emailed to admissions.sixthform@tbshs.org. It is best that these are recorded prior to the actual timetable being formulated to maximise the chances of it being a viable combination. Of course, subjects will not actually be finalised until Results Day on 25th August so it is possible to change subjects then, though choices will have to fit within the set option block structure.

2. Conditional offers:

Conditional offers to students will be sent **ELECTRONICALLY** to the student email registered on their Sixth Form application (**NOT their school email**) before the Easter holiday. It is vital that students check their external email address and acknowledge receipt of their offer by accepting or declining it and recording whether they will be attending our Induction days on 31st June & 1st July. Parents/carers will also receive a general notification when the offers have been sent.
