Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> January is a very, very important day globally. Thursday is Holocaust Memorial Day. We encourage the school community on Thursday evening at 8 pm to safely shine a light (perhaps using the torch from your 'phone) to remember.

Hannah Lewis MBE (pictured above) is a Holocaust survivor. Hannah was eight when her mother (pictured in the first picture below) was shot by the Nazis. Hannah's mother, Chaya, sacrificed her life for her daughter. When the Nazis came for Hannah's Jewish family, Hannah's mother kissed her daughter goodbye,



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hid Hannah where they were staying and went to meet the Nazi guards herself. Through a window, Hannah saw what happened to her mum. After the war, Hannah came to the UK. Hannah did not speak any English but she was warmly welcomed by the country, was married and had children. Hannah Lewis is the very model of resilience and a wonderful beacon of true inspiration. In 2018, Hannah received an MBE for her work in Holocaust Education.

Hannah regularly visits The Bishop's Stortford High School. She has spoken to generations of students and shown a courage beyond words to share her life. Hannah loves the school and the school loves her. Hannah always says she feels at home in the school.
