



MODULES/UNITS

Pupils have five lessons of French per fortnight.

They follow the course from the National Centre for Excellence in Language Pedagogy (NCELP), which builds on the Year 7 course. The focus remains on vocabulary, grammar and phonics.

Assessment: Pupils sit termly assessments, which will test a mixture of skills. Speaking is assessed continuously throughout the course.

Pupils also have access to vocabulary and grammar learning homework through Quizlet and the Gaminggrammar app to enhance independent learning.
