MODULES/UNITS

WJEC/Eugas A Level Component 1: Theatre Workshop- 20% (Externally moderated)

Learners participate in the creation, development and performance of a piece of theatre based on a *reinterpretation* of an extract from a text chosen from a list supplied by WJEC.

The piece must be developed using the techniques and working methods of **either** an influential theatre practitioner **or** a recognised theatre company.

Learners must produce:

- a realisation of the performance or design
- a creative log.

WJEC/Eduqas A Level Component 2 Text in Action - 40% (Visiting examiner)

Learners participate in the creation, development and performance of two pieces of theatre based on a stimulus supplied by WJEC/Eduqas:

- 1. a devised piece using the techniques and working methods of **either** an influential theatre practitioner **or** a recognised theatre company (a different practitioner or company to that chosen for Component 1)
- 2. an extract from a text in a different style chosen by the learner.

Learners must realise their performance live for the visiting examiner. Learners produce a process and evaluation report within **one** week of completion of the practical work.

WJEC/Edugas A Level Component 3: Text in Performance -40% (Written Exam 2 hr 30 mins)

Sections A and B Open book: Two questions, based on two different texts, one written pre-1956 and one written post-1956.

Section C: Closed book: A question based on a specified extract from:

The Curious Incident of the Dog in the Night-Time,

Mark Haddon, adapted by Simon Stephens
