

# **SUBJECT Key Stage 4**

### **MODULES/UNITS**

#### **AUTUMN TERM/SPRING TERM**

#### **Structures - Natural Forms**

Students will be introduced to the course by developing more refined skills and methods introduced at KS3. They will explore of a wide range of techniques whilst observing natural forms including ink, acrylic, photography, pencil and oil pastel.

From a set-up of their own design based on natural forms they develop a sustained acrylic painting. Advancing their knowledge of working with acrylic paint. Colour theory and paint application.

In the final stage of this project students will use their initial drawings of natural forms to create designs for a ceramic outcome which can be functional or purely decorative.

#### **SPRING TERM**

#### <u>Structures – Amazing Architecture</u>

Students will explore this theme initially together as a class with set tasks relating to the theme but this will lead to an independent development working with artists of their choice and in the materials of their choice. The outcome for this project is the year 10 exam.

#### **SUMMER TERM**

#### Reflections

Students will work from a specimen exam paper and develop work that is initially guided but becomes increasingly independent as they move into year 11. This work will lead onto their mock exams where they will create their own personalized outcome in a medium of their choice.

## **MODULES/UNITS**

#### **AUTUMN TERM**

#### Continuation of Reflections – independent development

During this term students will continue to be inspired by the theme of reflections and the specimen exam paper however they will develop this theme in a direction of interest to them. Students will have free choice on the artists they choose and the methods of working they feel is their strongest. This project will conclude with an outcome produced in timed conditions.

#### **SPRING AND SUMMER TERM**

Externally set task. This will count for 40% of their overall mark.
