MODULES/UNITS

Students have five lessons of French per fortnight.

The curriculum follows the Language Driven-Pedagogy (LDP) approach, which builds on the Year 7 course. The focus remains on phonics, vocabulary and grammar.

Assessment: Students sit termly assessments, which will test a mixture of skills. Speaking is assessed continuously throughout the course.

Students also have access to vocabulary and grammar learning homework through the Language Guide Booklet and **memrise** (app and website) to enhance independent learning.
