IT Work Experience with Raytheon

Raytheon UK is a technology company focused on Defence, Aerospace, Cyber & Intelligence with sites across the UK in England, Scotland and Wales.

At Raytheon, there is a large IT team with lots of experience and all staff are keen on sharing their knowledge with work experience students. After a successful couple of years running work experience they are adapting our process to include more students from a larger pool of local schools across Essex/Herts.

They are offering students the opportunity to spend a week at the Harlow site giving students an insight into how IT works in an industry setting. Over the weeklong placement they will spend time with many internal teams, understanding what they do on a day-to-day basis, helping to solve real challenges and learning how employees came to work in IT.

Additionally, during the week there will be some STEM activities, a CV workshop and a mock interview delivered by a senior member of staff to help the students prepare for their future.

The dates for 2026 are flexible at the moment, providing they don't clash with events in the company calendar, meaning that students can fit this experience around their studies easily. There are a few prerequisites that students must meet to be considered for the work experience.
