Year 9

AUTUMN TERM

Flight Project

Focusing on the theme of birds, students will explore a wide range of practises whilst developing knowledge of the assessment objectives and how to present and use a sketchbook to document their ideas and artist research. They will look at a variety of artists that have explore birds within their art. Students will develop their drawing skills and create 3D ceramic outcome.

SPRING TERM – Flight continued

Students will continue to explore the theme of Flight and will develop a sculptural wire outcome.

MODULES/UNITS

SPRING TERM – Expressive Portraits

Students will begin to explore the theme of portraits. They will learn how portraits have evolved with different art movements through time. They will learn how to draw a face in correct proportion and how to use and mix acrylic paint to achieve a variety of skin tones. Students will produce a detailed acrylic self-portrait painting.

SUMMER TERM – Expressive Portraits continued

During this final term students will study German Expressionist art movement and will develop a second portrait in acrylic exploring the distinct use of colour and paint application of these artists. Thy will then explore the German Expressionist woodblock artists and produce a lino print in this style.
